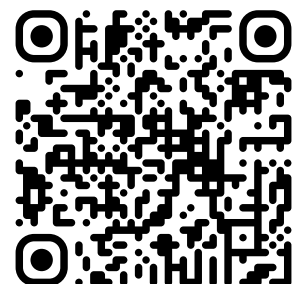

THE SHERRILL MILNES VOICE PROGRAMS

SAVANNAH VOICE FESTIVAL

The Savannah VOICE Festival, held each year in August, is a celebration of classical-voice. Through the Festival, VOICE brings together professional artists, emerging artists, and Milnes VOICE studio students to perform world-class opera, musical theater, and songs. More than 25 performances will be presented in the amazing ambiance of historic venues in Savannah, GA. Many VOICE alumni refer to the "Hostess City" as their musical home.

SCHOOL OUTREACH AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

In partnership with the Savannah-Chatham County Public School System, GA (and Pinellas County School System, FL), VOICE outreach enhances students' exposure to and appreciation of the classically-trained voice. Through live performances, original compositions, and participation in performances, VOICE educates the next generation of artists and music lovers. Current partnerships include: "Songs and Stories in the Squares," (presented in collaboration with the Historic Savannah Foundation) and our "VOICES That Heal" initiative (in partnership with Hospice Savannah) to comfort and soothe individuals in palliative care and their caregivers. This August, you will find VOICE singers performing at Kiwanis, Rotary, the Marshes, JEA and other civic organizations, as well as guest soloists in your place of worship.

VOICEXPERIENCE PRESENTS THE FLORIDA VOICE PROJECT

The Florida VOICE Project is a small, intensive vocal program that offers young singers the opportunity to develop their careers. Our faculty partner with singers during every phase of their journey, further developing their skills through honest evaluation and strategic planning.

MILNES VOICE STUDIO

The Milnes VOICE Studio, a program within the Savannah VOICE Festival, seeks to develop both artists' vocal and non-vocal skills (role preparation, networking, and vocal technique, etc.). Moreover, the VOICE Studio is designed as a stepping stone for young artists to transition from youthful programs to professional careers.

OPERA IDOL (AS PART OF THE VOICE GALA WEEK)

The annual Opera Idol vocal competition is a Master Class with Sherrill Milnes that allows four vocalists to compete for a full scholarship to attend the Milnes VOICE Studio in Savannah. Winners are selected by a panel of judges, including former Milnes VOICE Awardees George Shirley (tenor) and James Morris (bass-baritone) and 2024 Awardee Deborah Voigt (soprano).

The 1853 Gothic-Revival gem housed the military headquarters of General W. T. Sherman following the March-to-the-Sea during the Civil War.



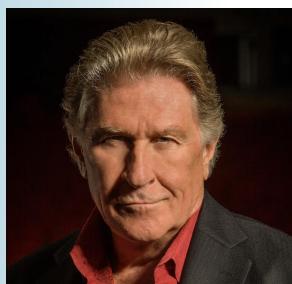
